At the end of each week you are invited to join us for Friday lunch and an exhibit curated by your children of all the activities and crafts they completed that week. Ages for History's Mysteries Camp: Rising First Graders through Rising Fifth Graders



June 17-21: Tall Tales Your campers will hear the wildly exaggerated and downright funny stories of some of America's first folk heroes. Some of these tales you may have heard and some may be new, but they are all larger than life.

June 24-28: The Who Was? This week's theme is based on a series of illustrated biographies for young readers featuring significant historical figures, including artists, scientists, and world leaders. Your camper will explore famous people from different places, times, and fields of study.

July 8-12: Heroes and Villains Some heroes are the villains if the story is turned around. This week your campers will learn about some children's books told from an opposite point of view. How does that changes things?

July 15 -19: Civilizations: Lost and Found In the days before Google Earth, entire cities could be lost under the sands of time or the waves of the sea. Today, some of the ancient places remain myths and some that were once thought to be myths have been found. We will explore a few of the tales and see what we might find along the way. July 22-26: Mad Scientists Grab your lab coat and your goggles, because this week at camp we are going to try out some fun and crazy science experiments!

July 29-August 2: Horrible Histories History can be horrible and this week your camper will learn about some of the less than pretty events. Campers will investigate everything from the "Savage Stone Age" to the "Troublesome Twentieth Century" based on the British book and television series.

August 5-9: Castaways Like Robinson Crusoe or the Swiss Family Robinson, your camper will spend the week learning different ways to survive the elements if they are ever stranded on a desert island.
