Vocabulary:

Clockwise- during the same way as the hands of a clock

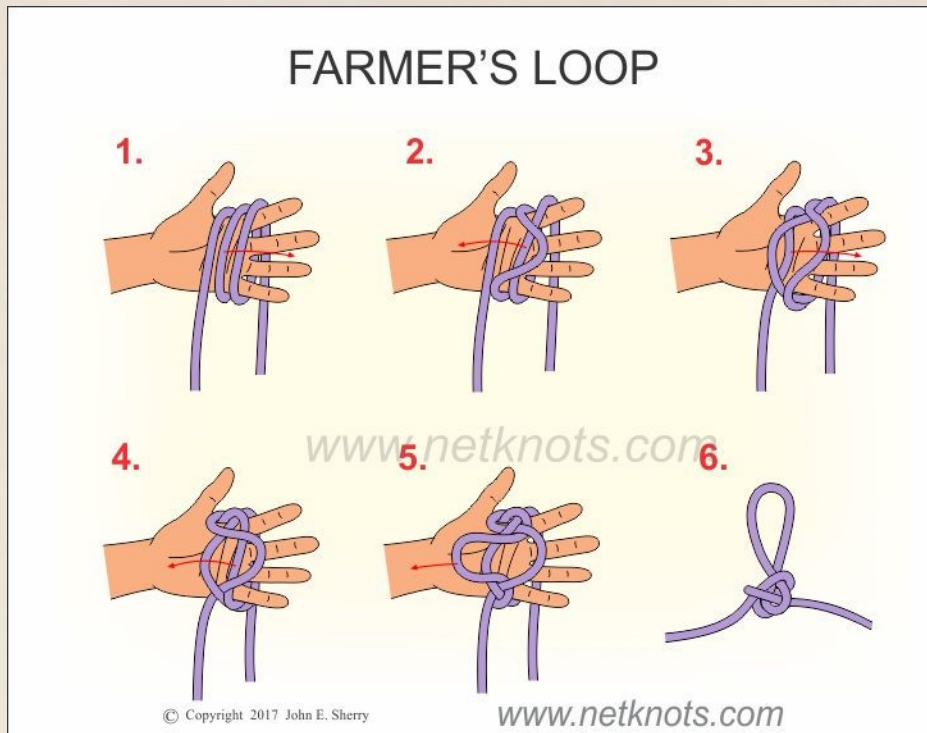
Hemp- fibers from a long plant of many types used for making rope, cord and fabric

Lasso- a long rope with a loop at one end used to catch horses and cattle

Reins- ropes attached to the front of a horse to help lead it

Tangled- threads snarled together or knotted

Twine- cord made from threads twisted together
